**Cancellation of Tuition** - Tuition can only be cut-off at the end of a school term, and half a term's notice in writing must be given (ie if you would like tuition to cease at the end of the Winter Term, you must notify us in writing before the Winter Half-Term holiday). Failure to do so will entitle you to payment for the following term of tuition.

**Instrument Hire** - Beginners will have the opportunity to hire an instrument from the academy at a reduced rate for the first year of study, following which should they wish to continue then help and advice will be given into how to purchase or hire a suitable instrument. For some instruments, children will have the opportunity to hire an instrument from the academy for a longer period of time. Occasionally certain instruments which have been donated to the academy will be loaned free of charge to children in need of support. Please enquire for further information.

**Parent's Information Pack** - The academy will provide parents with an Information Pack which includes information on subjects such as Instrument Maintenance, Practice Routine, Preparing for Concerts and Exams, Extra-Musical Activities, and other important issues.

**Shared Lessons** - For the Junior Department only some teachers may prefer to take children in pairs for double the amount of time. The decision to do so is at the discretion of the teacher, as it is based on the suitability of both the child and the instrument.
